

AN ACT

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, rules governing the Health Care Safety Net Administration to conform with statutory changes and update eligibility requirements and standards on eligibility determinations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Health Care Safety Net Administration Rulemaking Approval Emergency Act of 2022”.

Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the timing requirements to approve or disapprove proposed rules under section 7a of the Health Care Privatization Amendment Act of 2001, effective March 30, 2004 (D.C. Law 15-109; D.C. Official Code § 7-1406), the Council approves the proposed rules of the Department of Health Care Finance that were transmitted to the Council by the Mayor and attached to the Health Care Safety Net Administration Rulemaking Approval Resolution of 2022, as introduced on February 9, 2022 (P.R. 24-582), to amend Chapter 33 (Health Care Safety Net Administration) of Subtitle B (Public Health and Medicine) of Title 22 (Health) of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, regarding the Health Care Safety Net Administration, which were published in the District of Columbia Register on November 19, 2021, at 68 DCR 012292.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

1 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement from the Chief Financial Officer
2 as the fiscal impact statement required by Section 602(c)(3) of the Home Rule Act,
3 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Codes §1-206.02 (c) (3).)

4 Sect 4. Effective date.

5 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
6 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for
7 no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of
8 Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
9 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
