21	Sec. 2. Pursuant to Section 1 of an Act to authorize the transfer of jurisdiction over public
22	land in the District of Columbia, approved May 20, 1932 (47 Stat. 161; D.C. Official Code §10-
23	111), the Council of the District of Columbia approves the transfer of jurisdiction of approximately
24	126,167 square feet comprising a portion of Reservation 405 (comprising a portion of Lot 809 in
25	Square 5450, a portion of Lot 802 in Square 5464, a portion of Lot 805 in Square 5465, and portions
26	of Lots 15, 800, 801, and 802 in Square 5467), as shown on the Surveyor's plat in S.O. 21-07525,
27	from the Department of the Interior, National Park Service to the District of Columbia.
28	Sec. 3. Transmittal.
29	The Secretary to the Council of the District of Columbia shall transmit a copy of this
30	resolution, upon its adoption, to the Mayor, the Surveyor of the District of Columbia, the Executive
31	Director of the National Capital Planning Commission, the Speaker of the United States House of

32	Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the United States, the Director of the National Park
33	Service, and the Regional Director of the National Capital Region of the National Park Service.
