16	To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to close a loophole in the
17	existing law that allows large out-of-state firms to certify as local business enterprises.

19	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
20	resolution may be cited as the "Local Business Enterprise Clarification Emergency Declaration
21	Resolution of 2022".
22	
23	Sec. 2. (a) The goal of the Department of Small and Local Business Development is to
24	
24	stimulate and foster the economic growth and development of businesses based in the District of
25	Columbia. Due to a loophole, many large, out-of-District businesses have been able to legally
23	Columbia. Due to a loophole, many large, out-of-District businesses have been able to regarry
26	certify as local business enterprises.

27	(b) The Council has enacted emergency and temporary legislation to close this loophole.
28	The most recent legislation, the Local Business Clarification Temporary Amendment Act of
29	2021, effective September 22, 2021 (D.C. Law 24-35; 68 DCR 7989), expires on May 5, 2022
30	("temporary legislation").
31	(c) It is important to keep the provisions of the temporary legislation effective law until

35	Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
36	enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Local
37	Business Clarification Emergency Amendment Act of 2022 be adopted after a single reading.
38	Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
