30	(b) The Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of
31	Behavioral Health, awarded Contract No. CW93586 for \$885,000 for the period August
32	18, 2021 to August 17, 2022.
33	(c) Modification No. 1 is now necessary to increase the total amount for the base
34	year to \$1,416,915.
