14	To amend, on an emergency basis, the COVID-19 Hotel Recovery Grant Program Act of 2021 to
15	revise the reduction in occupancy or revenue that a business must have incurred from

17	revise the deadline by which the Mayor must submit a report to the Council on the grants

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
21	act may be cited as the "COVID-19 Hotel Recovery Grant Program Emergency Amendment Act
22	of 2022".
23	Sec. 2. Section 2192 of the COVID Recovery Grant Program Act of 2021, effective
24	November 13, 2021 (D.C. Law 24-45; D.C. Official Code § 30-301), is amended as follows:
25	(a) Subsection (a)(5) is amended by striking the figure "40%" both times it appears and
26	inserting the figure "35%" in its place.
27	(b) Subsection (f)(2) is amended by striking the phrase "June 1, 2022" and inserting the
28	phrase "July 15, 2022" in its place.
29	Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.
30	The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact
31	statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved
32	October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).
33	Sec. 5. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
