On Friday, May 20, 2022, Councilmember Anita Bonds will hold a public roundtable to discuss PR24-0632, “Real Property Tax Appeals Commission Cliftine Jones Confirmation Resolution of 2022,” PR24-0633, “Real Property Tax Appeals Commission May S. Chan Confirmation Resolution of 2022,” PR24-0634, “Real Property Tax Appeals Commission Trent Williams Confirmation Resolution of 2022,” PR24-0647, “District of Columbia Housing Authority Board of Commissioners Edward Fisher Confirmation Resolution of 2022,” and PR24-0655, “District of Columbia Housing Authority Board of Commissioners Melissa Lee Confirmation Resolution of 2022”.

PR24-0632, would reappoint Cliftine Jones as of full-time Commissioner of the Real Property Tax Appeals Commission, for a term to end April 30, 2026.

PR24-0633 would reappoint May S. Chan as full-time Commissioner of the Real Property Tax Appeals Commission, for a term to end April 30, 2026.

PR24-0634 would reappoint Trent Williams as full-time Chairperson of the Real Property Tax Appeals Commission, for a term to end April 30, 2026.

PR24-0647 would appoint Edward Fisher as public commissioner of the District of Columbia Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, replacing Melissa Lee, to serve the remainder of an unexpired term ending July 12, 2022, and for a new term to end July 12, 2025.

PR24-0655 would appoint Melissa Lee as a member with professional experience designing and developing public and private multi-family housing of the District of Columbia Housing Authority Board of Commissioners for a term to end July 12, 2025.

Persons who wish to testify are requested to either email the Committee at housing@dccouncil.us or telephone the Committee at (202) 724-8198, at least two business days before the hearing and provide their name, address, telephone number, email address, organizational affiliation and title. Each witness will receive an individual Zoom invitation for the hearing in a separate e-mail. Witnesses are encouraged to submit an electronic version of their testimony to housing@dccouncil.us. Oral testimony will be limited to 5 minutes for those testifying on behalf of an organization and 3 minutes for those testifying on behalf of themselves.

All Councilmembers will receive an individual Zoom invitation for the hearing in a separate email. If a Councilmember does not have a separate link for each, please contact the Committee at housing@dccouncil.us.

Witnesses who anticipate needing language interpretation or require sign language interpretation are encouraged to inform the Committee of the need as soon as possible but no later than five business days before the proceeding. The Committee will make every effort to fulfill timely requests, however requests received in less than five business days may not be fulfilled and alternatives may be offered.

If someone is unable to testify at the public hearing, written statements are encouraged and will be made a part of the official record.
