Councilmember Elissa Silverman, Chairperson of the Committee on Labor and Workforce Development, announces a public roundtable before the Committee on PR24-646, the “Public Employee Relations Board Douglas A. Warshof Confirmation Resolution of 2022.” The roundtable will be held on Thursday, May 19, 2022, at 4:00 p.m. PR 24-646 would confirm the reappointment of Mr. Warshof as the chairperson of the Public Employee Relations Board (PERB). PERB is an impartial, quasi-judicial independent agency that resolves labor-management disputes between District government agencies and labor organizations representing agency employees.

Witnesses may use their phone or computer to participate in this virtual roundtable. Those who wish to testify must sign up no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 17, 2022, by providing their information using this [link](#). Witnesses must provide their name, email address, telephone number, organizational affiliation (if any), and job title (if any), as well whether they require language interpretation or sign language interpretation. Witnesses who require language interpretation or sign language interpretation are requested to email the labor committee at [labor@dccouncil.us](mailto:labor@dccouncil.us) as soon as possible, but no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 11, 2022, stating their need for interpretation and requested language.. The Council’s Office of the Secretary will fulfill timely requests for language interpretation services; however, requests received later than May 11 may not be fulfilled due to vendor availability.

On Wednesday, May 18, the Committee will email witnesses who signed up by May 17, in order to provide them with details about how to participate in the roundtable via the Zoom platform. Only witnesses who have signed up by the Tuesday, May 17, 5:00 pm deadline will be permitted to participate. Those planning to testify are encouraged to submit an electronic copy of written testimony by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 17 so that staff may distribute testimonies to Committee members and staff before the roundtable.

If anyone is unable to testify at the roundtable, written statements will be made a part of the official record. Written statements should be submitted by email to [labor@dccouncil.us](mailto:labor@dccouncil.us). Additionally, the public may provide testimony by voice mail by calling (202) 455-0153, stating and spelling the witness’s name, stating any organizational affiliation, and speaking slowly to

provide a statement to be transcribed and included in the record. The record will close at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, May 23, 2022.
