A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, the negotiated compensation agreement submitted by the Mayor for employees employed by the Department of Behavioral Health (DBH) who are represented by Committee of Interns and Residents, Service Employees International Union, CTW, CLC (CIR/SEIU).

RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Compensation Agreement between the District of Columbia Government Department of Behavioral Health and the Committee of Interns and Residents, Service Employees International Union, CTW, CLC Emergency Approval Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to Section 1717(j) of the District of Columbia Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Official Code § 1-617.17(j)), the Council of the District of Columbia approves the collective bargaining agreement and attached related pay schedules, of the contract negotiated through collective bargaining between DBH and CIR/SEIU, which was transmitted to the Council by the Mayor on _____, 20__.
