A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Contract No. NFPHC-MS-22-C-00043 Modification between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation, commonly known as United Medical Center (“Hospital”), and Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc., for the provision of respiratory therapist staffing services (“Contract”), and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. NFPHC-MS-22-C-00043 Modification between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Contract No. NFPHC-MS-22-C-00043 Modification (“Contract”) between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation (“Hospital”) and Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. for the provision of respiratory therapist staffing services, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under this Contract.

38 (b) UMC needed respiratory therapist staffing services and entered into an initial  
39 agreement that had a base year value of \$500,000.00 for the period of October 11, 2021  
40 through October 10, 2022.

41 (c) Additional funds are needed while alternative staffing services were sought, so  
42 the parties now propose entering Modification #1 for an additional \$900,000.00, with the  
43 same period, October 11, 2021 through October 10, 2022.

44 (d) If Proposed Modification #1 is approved, the combined value of the Base Year  
45 agreement (October 11, 2021 through October 10, 2022) would have an aggregate value  
46 that exceeds \$1 million in a 12-month period, and therefore Council approval is  
47 necessary.

48 (e) Without this approval, Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. cannot be  
49 paid for these critical services provided and to be provided in excess of \$999,999.99.

50 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2  
51 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Contract No. NFPHC-MS-  
52 22-C-00043 Modification between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Maxim  
53 Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency  
54 Amendment Act of 2022, be adopted after a single reading.

55 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
