A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 to Contract No. CW85843 with Maximus US Services, Inc. to provide operations and maintenance for the District's Provider Data Management System and Service and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Modification Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 to Contract No. CW85843 with Maximus US Services, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022".

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 to Contract No. CW85843 with Maximus US Services, Inc., to provide operations and maintenance for the District's Provider Data Management System and Service, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

(b) By Modification No. 2, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Health Care Finance, exercised a partial option of option year one

34 of Contract No. CW85843 for \$778,199.94 for the period January 7, 2022 through April
35 6, 2022.

36 (c) Modification Nos. 3, 4, 5, and 6 were administrative modifications.

37 (d) Modification No. 7 exercised another partial option of option year one for
38 \$221,800.06 for the period April 7, 2022 through May 6, 2022.

39 (e) Modification No. 8 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option year
40 one from May 7, 2022 through January 6, 2023 for a total not-to-exceed amount of
41 \$3,112,799.76 for option year one.

42 (f) Council approval is necessary since this will increase the value of the contract
43 by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

44 (g) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
45 Without this approval, Maximus US Services, Inc. cannot be paid for goods and services
46 provided in excess of \$1 million for the period January 7, 2022 through January 6, 2023.

47 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
48 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
49 necessary that the Modification Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 to Contract No. CW85843 with
50 Maximus US Services, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of
51 2022 be adopted after a single reading.

52 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
