To amend, on an emergency basis, the Legalization of Marijuana for Medical Treatment Initiative of 1999 to allow individuals 21 years of age and older to self-certify that they are utilizing cannabis for medical purposes.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
act may be cited as the "Medical Marijuana Self-Certification Emergency Amendment Act of 2022".
Sec. 2. The Legalization of Marijuana for Medical Treatment Initiative of 1999, effective
July 27, 2010 (D.C. Law 18-210; D.C. Official Code § 7-1671.01 et seq.), is amended as follows
(a) Section 3(c)(1)(A) (D.C. Official Code § 7-1671.02(c)(1)(A)) is amended to read as
follows:
"(A) Obtained a signed, written recommendation from an authorized
practitioner within the last 2 years in accordance with section 5, except for individuals 21 years
of age and older who shall be permitted to self-certify on a form provided by ABRA that they are
utilizing cannabis for medical purposes as part of the registration process; and".
