Subject:	Request to Agendize CRE measures for the June 7, 2022 Legislative Meeting

I request that you place the following measures on the agenda of the June 7, 2022 legislative meeting:

- The Ban on Non-Compete Agreements Applicability Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022
- Ban on Non-Compete Agreements Applicability Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2022.

The purpose of the CRE legislation is to bridge the current gap in applicability between Ban on Non-Compete Agreements Applicability Emergency Amendment Act of 2022, which will expire on June 26, 2022, and the enactment of the Ban on Non-Compete Agreements Applicability Temporary Amendment Act of 2022 which is not expected to become law until July 20, 2022. The previous emergency and temporary measures postpone the enactment and applicability of the District's 2019 ban on non-compete agreements to October 1, 2022 when amendments to the law should also be finalized.
