Please place the following measures on the agenda for the June 7, 2022 Legislative Meeting:

- Protecting Consumers from Unjust Debt Collection Practices Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022
- Protecting Consumers from Unjust Debt Collection Practices Emergency Amendment Act of 2022
- Protecting Consumers from Unjust Debt Collection Practices Temporary Amendment Act of 2022

On August 3, 2021, the Council approved the Protecting Consumers from Unjust Debt Collection Practices Temporary Amendment Act of 2021, effective October 27, 2021 (D.C. Law 24-40; 68 DCR 12181) which expires on June 9, 2022. The permanent measure (Bill 24-357) will be up for second reading on June 7, 2022. A second round of emergency and temporary legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law. The temporary measure will sunset on January 1, 2023, at which time Bill 24-357 will go into effect.
