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A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

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IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

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To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to amend D.C. Official Code § 47-2853.133 to re-establish an exemption for engaging in engineering work without a license for employees and consultants of the District government and independent agencies who are under the supervision of a professional engineer.

RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That

this resolution may be cited as the “Engineering Licensure Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) On May 3, 2022, the Council adopted the Engineering Licensure Emergency Amendment Act of 2022, enacted May 23, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-423; 69 DCR 6233) which expires on August 21, 2022.

(b) On June 7, 2022, the Council adopted the Engineering Licensure Temporary Amendment Act of 2022. The temporary measure was transmitted to the Mayor on July 5, 2022 with a response due by July 19, 2022, after which it will be transmitted to Congress for a 30-day review period.

(c) This identical emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary measure.

1           Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances  
2   in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances, making it necessary that the  
3   Engineering Licensure Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2022 be  
4   adopted after a single reading.

5           Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
