

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

1 To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need
2 to extend the deadline for submission of ward task force reports on the redistricting of
3 ANC areas and single-member districts, to amend the Advisory Neighborhood
4 Commissions Act of 1975 to extend the deadlines for the Council to enact legislation
5 adjusting boundaries and for the Board of Elections to make available nominating
6 petitions to candidates, and to amend the District of Columbia Election Code of 1955 to
7 authorize the Board of Elections to draw precinct lines for the November 2022 general
8 election without Council approval.

9 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
10 resolution may be cited as the “Advisory Neighborhood Commission Redistricting Deadline
11 Extension Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

12 Sec. 2. (a) The Advisory Neighborhood Commission Redistricting Deadline Extension
13 Emergency Act of 2022, effective March 28, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-347; 69 DCR 2616) (the
14 “emergency act”) will expire on June 26, 2022.

15 (b) The Advisory Neighborhood Commission Redistricting Deadline Extension
16 Temporary Act of 2022, enacted on May 3, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-391; 69 DCR 4404) (the
17 “temporary act”) is under congressional review and is projected to become law on July 20, 2022.

18 (c) There will be a gap in applicability of the law between the expiration of the
19 emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act, unless the Council adopts another
20 emergency version of this legislation.

21 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
22 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
23 Advisory Neighborhood Commission Redistricting Deadline Extension Congressional Review
24 Emergency Amendment Act of 2022 be adopted after a single reading.

25 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
