A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 15, 16, and 17 to Contract No. CW63144 with Consumer Direct District of Columbia, LLC to provide Vendor Fiscal/Employer Agency Financial Management services and support broker services to Medicaid participants enrolled in the District’s Medicaid Home and Community-Based §1915 (c) waivers and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 15, 16, and 17 to Contract No. CW63144 with Consumer Direct District of Columbia, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 15, 16, and 17 to Contract No. CW63144 with Consumer Direct District of Columbia, LLC, to provide Vendor Fiscal/Employer Agency Financial Management services and support broker services to Medicaid participants enrolled in the District’s Medicaid Home and Community-Based §1915 (c) waivers, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

35 (b) By Modification No. 15, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on  
36 behalf of the Department of Health Care Finance, exercised a partial option of option  
37 year three of Contract No. CW63144 for \$955,000 for the period October 1, 2021  
38 through December 31, 2021.

39 (c) Modification No. 16 corrected the number of participants and increased the  
40 contract amount by \$662,600 for the same period.

41 (d) Modification No. 17 exercised the remainder of option year three from  
42 January 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022 for a total not-to-exceed amount of  
43 \$5,804,100 for option year three.

44 (e) Council approval is necessary since this will increase the value of the contract  
45 by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

46 (f) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.  
47 Without this approval, Consumer Direct District of Columbia, LLC cannot be paid for  
48 goods and services provided in excess of \$1 million for the period October 1, 2021 to  
49 September 30, 2022.

50 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the  
51 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it  
52 necessary that the Modification Nos. 15, 16, and 17 to Contract No. CW63144 with  
53 Consumer Direct District of Columbia, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization  
54 Emergency Act of 2022 be adopted after a single reading.

55 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
