A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 8b, and 9 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0103 with Edgewood/Brookland Family Support Collaborative to provide community-based child welfare service delivery systems and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 8b, and 9 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0103 with Edgewood/Brookland Family Support Collaborative Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 8b, and 9 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0103 with Edgewood/Brookland Family Support Collaborative, to provide community-based child welfare service delivery systems, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

(b) By Modification No. 6, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Child and Family Services Agency, exercised a partial option of option year one of

35 through March 20, 2022.

36 (c) Modification No. 7 increased the partial option amount to \$999,633.42.

37 (d) Modification No. 8 exercised another partial option of option year one from
38 March 21, 2022 through June 30, 2022 and increased the not-to-exceed amount by
39 \$596,697.96.

40 (e) Modification No. 8b deleted and replaced the price schedules for the periods
41 of performances ranging from October 1, 2021, through March 31, 2022 and exercised
42 the partial option period of performance from April 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022. The
43 total not-to-exceed amount for the periods of performance October 1, 2021 through June
44 30, 2022 is \$1,595,756.91

45 (f) Modification No. 9 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option year
46 one from July 1, 2022 through September 30, 2022 for a total not-to-exceed amount of
47 \$2,133,954.65 for option year one.

48 (f) Council approval is necessary since this will increase the value of the contract
49 by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

50 (e) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
51 Without this approval, Edgewood/Brookland Family Support Collaborative cannot be
52 paid for goods and services provided in excess of \$1 million for the period October 1,
53 2021 through September 30, 2022.

54 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
55 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
56 necessary that the Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 8b, and 9 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-

57 0103 with Edgewood/Brookland Family Support Collaborative Approval and Payment

58 Authorization Emergency Act of 2022 be adopted after a single reading.

59 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
