19	Sec. 2. (a) On March 1, 2022, the Council passed, and on March 28, 2022, the Mayor
20	signed, the Ban on Non-Compete Agreements Applicability Emergency Amendment Act of
21	2022, effective March 28, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-350; 69 DCR 2622) ("emergency act"), which will
22	expire on June 26, 2022.
23	(b) On April 5, 2022, the Council passed on second reading, and on May 3, 2022 the
24	Mayor signed, the Ban on Non-Compete Agreements Applicability Temporary Amendment Act
25	of 2022, enacted May 3, 2022 (D.C. Act 24-392; 69 DCR 4406) ("temporary act"), which is not
26	expected to become law until July 20, 2022.
27	(c) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the
28	expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Ban on Non-Compete Agreements Applicability Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2022 be adopted after a single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
