I request that the following measure be agendized for the June 7<sup>th</sup> Regular Legislative Meeting:

Congressional Review Emergency Legislation:

- State Board of Education Membership Eligibility Congressional Review Emergency **Declaration Resolution of 2022**
- State Board of Education Membership Eligibility Congressional Review Emergency **Amendment Act of 2022**

On March 1, 2022, the Council passed the State Board of Education Membership Eligibility Emergency Amendment Act of 2022 to enable current DCPS employees to run for - and serve on, if elected - the State Board of Education. The emergency act is set to expire on June 26 while the temporary bill is not projected to go into effect until July 20, 2022. This congressional review emergency measure is needed to prevent a gap in legislation and preserve DCPS employees' eligibility for service on the State Board of Education in advance of the nominating petition signature collection process which begins for SBOE Ward candidates on June 17, 2022.
