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16 To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to officially designating the street in Square
17 5116 between 45th Street, N.E. and Kenilworth Avenue, N.E. as Amin Muslim Street and
18 the street in Square 5116 that connects to Quarles Street, N.E. as Denise Stanley Street.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
21 act may be cited as the “Kenilworth Courts Official Street Designation Emergency Declaration
22 Resolution of 2022”.

23 Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to officially designate the street in Square
24 5116 between 45th Street, N.E. and Kenilworth Avenue, N.E. as Amin Muslim Street and the
25 street in Square 5116 that connects to Quarles Street, N.E. as Denise Stanley Street.

26 (b) Bill 22-436, the “Kenilworth Courts Official Street Designation Act of 2022” is
27 currently under review by the Council. The measure was marked up by the Committee of the
28 Whole on September 20, 2022 and is scheduled for final reading on October 4, 2022.

29 (c) The underlying legislation is related to the redevelopment of the Kenilworth Courts
30 residential community which will provide up to 166 new affordable residential units and will
31 provide official street names for two new streets.

32 (d) In order for the Department of Consumer Affairs to issue a certificate of occupancy
33 for the units, street addresses for the buildings are necessary, which requires an official name for
34 the streets.

35 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia finds that the circumstances enumerated
36 in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the “Kenilworth Courts
37 Official Street Designation Emergency Act of 2022” be adopted after a single reading.

38 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
