On Wednesday, September 21, 2022, Councilmember Kenyan R. McDuffie, Chairperson of the Committee on Business and Economic Development, will hold a public hearing to consider the following measures:

- Bill 24-0370, the “Electrical Utility Underground Work Wage Act of 2021”
- Bill 24-0823, the “206 Elm Street, N.W. Real Property Tax Abatement Amendment Act of 2022”

Bill 24-0370 would establish a prevailing wage track for workers employed on underground projects by electric utility contractors and subcontractors. In advance of this public hearing, the Committee on Business and Economic Development will convene working groups over the summer.

Bill 24-0823, the “206 Elm Street, N.W. Real Property Tax Abatement Amendment Act of 2022” would provide a real property tax abatement to Lot 805, Square 3087, located at 206 Elm Street, N.W., during tax year 2023.
