18 To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. M02 and M03 to Contract No.
19 DCAM-21-NC-RFP-0015, between the Department of General Services and
20 Spectrum Management, LLC increasing the aggregate not to exceed amount of the
21 Contract for Option Year One to \$3,403,270.51, and authorizing payment to
22 Spectrum Management, LLC for goods and services received and to be received
23 under these modifications.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that
26 this act may be cited as “Modification Nos. M02 and M03 to Contract No. DCAM-21-NC-
27 RFP-0015 with Spectrum Management, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization
28 Emergency Act of 2022”.

29 Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
30 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51) and
31 notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act
32 of 2010, as amended, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-
33 352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. M02 and M03 to Contract No. DCAM-
34 21-NC-RFP-0015 between the Department of General Services and Spectrum
35 Management, LLC for consolidated maintenance services at Marion S. Barry, Jr. Building,

1 increasing the aggregate not-to-exceed amount for Option Year One by \$2,777,725.43,
2 from \$625,545.08 to \$3,403,270.51, and authorizing payment to Spectrum Management,
3 LLC for services received and to be received under these modifications.

4 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

5 The Council adopts the fiscal statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact
6 statement required by section 4(a) of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
7 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47(a)).

8 Sec. 4. Effective date.

9 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
10 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no
11 longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of
12 Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
13 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
