18 To amend, on an emergency basis, the Immunization of School Students Act of 1979 to postpone
19 the date by which students must be vaccinated against COVID-19.
20

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may
22 be cited as the “Coronavirus Immunization of School Students Emergency Amendment Act of
23 2022”.

24 Sec. 2. The Immunization of School Students Act of 1979, effective September 28, 1979
25 (D.C. Law 3-20; D.C. Official Code § 38-501 *et seq.*), is amended as follows:

26 (a) Section 3(b) (D.C. Official Code §38-502(b)) is amended by striking the phrase
27 “2022-2023” and inserting the phrase “2023-2024” in its place.

28 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

29 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the
30 fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule
31 Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

32 Sec. 4. Effective date.

33 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
34 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
35 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
36 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
37 Columbia Register.
