18 To amend, on a temporary basis, the Immunization of School Students Act of 1979 to postpone
19 the date by which students must be vaccinated against COVID-19.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may
21 be cited as the “Coronavirus Immunization of School Students Temporary Amendment Act of
22 2022”.

23 Sec. 2. The Immunization of School Students Act of 1979, effective September 28, 1979
24 (D.C. Law 3-20; D.C. Official Code § 38-501 *et seq.*), is amended as follows:

25 (a) Section 3(b) (D.C. Official Code §38-502(b)) is amended by striking the phrase
26 “2022-2023” and inserting the phrase “2023-2024” in its place.

27 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

28 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal
29 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
30 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

31 Sec. 4. Effective date.

(a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.

(b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
