BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Coronavirus Immunization of School Students Temporary Amendment Act of 2022". Sec. 2. The Immunization of School Students Act of 1979, effective September 28. 1979 (D.C. Law 3-20; D.C. Official Code § 38-501 et seq.), is amended as follows: (a) Section 3(b) (D.C. Official Code §38-502(b)) is amended by striking the phrase "2022-2023" and inserting the phrase "2023-2024" in its place. Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a). Sec. 4. Effective date.

- (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
