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A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on a temporary basis, the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development Limited Grant-Making Authority Act of 2012 to provide a technical amendment to the Small Business Relief Grant Program.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “The Small Business Relief Grant Program Temporary Amendment Act of 2022”.

Sec.2. Section 2032(1)(6) of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development Limited Grant-Making Authority Act of 2012, effective September 20, 2012 (Law 19-168; D.C. Official Code § 1-328.04(1)(6), is amended to read as follows:

“(6)(A) With the exception of the Small Business Relief Grant Program authorized by subsection (1) of this section for which the cap shall be 7%, the Deputy Mayor may use up to 2% of the funds allocated for the grants in this subsection for administrative expenses associated with implementing the grant programs authorized in subsections (j) through (v) of this section.”.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code §1-206.02(c)(3)).

29 Sec. 4. Effective Date.

30 (a) This act shall take effect following the approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
31 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional
32 review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
33 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1), and publication in the
34 District of Columbia Register.

35 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
