31	Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Contract No.
32	NFPHCNUR-19-C-003 Modification 6 ("Contract") between the Not-for-Profit Hospital
33	Corporation ("Hospital") and NFPHCNUR-19-C-003 for the provision for specialty and
34	non-specialty temporary assignment nurses and to authorize payment for the services
35	received and to be received under this Contract.

36	(b) In June 2022, the Council approved A24-477, which consisted of Option Year
37	1 of the Contract, Mods 1 & 2, (\$1,000,000; October 31, 2020 – October 30, 2021), and
38	Option Year 2 of the Contract, Mods 3-5, (\$1,800,000; October 31, 2021 – October 30,
39	2022)
40	(c) UMC's need for specialty and non-specialty temporary assignment nurses
41	continues as the hospital faces the nationwide staffing shortage, increasing agency costs,
42	challenging negotiations, the pending closure, and the ongoing epidemics (COVID-19,
43	Omicron, and other variants).
44	(d) If Proposed Modification 6 in the amount of \$1,200,000, is approved, the
45	combined value of Option Year 2 would total \$3,000,000.00 for the period October 31,
46	2021 through October 30, 2022, and would have an aggregate value that exceeds \$1
47	million in a 12-month period; therefore Council approval is necessary.
