Emergency Legislation

This emergency and temporary legislation would amend the Campaign Finance Reform Amendment Act of 2018 to modify the applicability date for the provisions related to so-called "pay-to-play" government contracting. When the Act was funded, the Council revised the applicability clause to have the provisions apply to contracts entered into or executed on or after November 9, 2022, the day after the 2022 General Election. In making this revision, the Council's intent was that the provisions should apply to all elections after the 2022 General Election, not that they should apply to political committees organized in support of candidates elected to office in the 2022 General Election. This legislation clarifies that the provisions relating to "pay-to-play" government contracting do not apply to an inaugural or transition committee organized in 2022. As these provisions now apply to contracts entered into on or after November 9, 2022, this clarification must be passed on an emergency basis.
