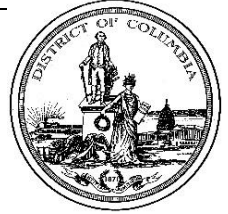

On Monday, January 30, 2023, Councilmember Anita Bonds will hold a public roundtable on PR25-009, the “District of Columbia Board of Ethics and Government Accountability Melissa Tucker Confirmation Resolution of 2022” and PR 25-0010 the “District of Columbia Board of Ethics and Government Accountability Norma Hutcheson Confirmation Resolution of 2022”. The roundtable will be held on Monday, January 30, 2023, at 1:00 p.m. via Zoom Video Conference Broadcast.

The purpose of PR25-009 is to reappoint Melissa Tucker as a member of the Board of Ethics and Government Accountability, for a term to end July 1, 2028. Moreover, the stated purpose of PR25-0010 is to reappoint Norma Hutcheson as a member of the District of Columbia Board of Ethics and Government Accountability, for a term to end July 1, 2028. The objective of this roundtable is to receive testimony from government and public witnesses regarding the reappointment of the aforementioned nominees for their respective positions.

Persons who wish to testify are requested to either email the Committee at execadmin-labor@dccouncil.gov or telephone the Committee at (202) 724-8198, at least two business days before the hearing and provide their name, address, telephone number, email address, organizational affiliation, and title. Each witness will receive an individual Zoom invitation for the hearing in a separate e-mail. Witnesses are encouraged to submit an electronic version of their testimony to execadmin-labor@dccouncil.gov. Oral testimony will be limited to 5 minutes for those testifying on behalf of an organization and 3 minutes for those testifying on behalf of themselves.
