25	School Students Emergency Amendment Act of 2022". The Act became law on November 22,

27	(b) On November 15, 2022, the Council adopted the "Coronavirus Immunization of

- (d) This identical emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between
 the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.
- Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
 Criminal Justice Involvement Reduction Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of
 2023 must be adopted after a single reading.
 - Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
