A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 05, 06, 07 and 08 to Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0027, between the Department of General Services and Superior Services and Associates, Inc. to provide comprehensive janitorial services for the Metropolitan Police Department (“MPD”) and Fire & Emergency Medical Service Department (“FEMS”), and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under these modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this act may be cited as “Modification Nos. 05, 06, 07 and 08 to Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0027 with Superior Services and Associates, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2022”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202(a) of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, as amended, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02(a)), the Council approves Modification Nos. 05, 06, 07 and 08 to Contract No. DCAM-18-NC-0027 with Superior Services and Associates, Inc. to provide comprehensive janitorial services for MPD and FEMS and authorizes payment in the not-

1 to-exceed amount of \$2,471,976.64 for the goods and services received and to be received  
2 under these modifications.

4 The Council adopts the fiscal statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal  
5 impact statement required by section 4(a) of the General Legislative Procedures Act of  
6 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47(a)).

7 Sec. 4. Effective date.

8 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto  
9 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no  
10 longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of  
11 Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved  
12 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
