A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 18, 19, and 20 to Contract No. CW63174 with Immediate Mailing Services, Inc. to provide printing and mailing services for the District of Columbia Access System and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. CW63174 with Immediate Mailing Services, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 18, 19, and 20 to Contract No. CW63174 with Immediate Mailing Services, Inc. to provide printing and mailing services for the District of Columbia Access System and authorizes payment in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1,036,950.90 for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

44 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
