A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 19 and 20 to Human Care Agreement No. CW77620 with DigiDoc, Inc. to provide nursing services to care for eligible students during transport to and from school and programs, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 19 and 20 to Human Care Agreement No. CW77620 with DigiDoc, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists a need to approve Modification Nos. 19 and 20 to Human Care Agreement No. CW77620 with DigiDoc, Inc. to provide nursing services to care for eligible students during transport to and from school and programs, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modification.

(b) By Modification No. 19, dated December 1, 2022, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Office of the State Superintendent of Education, exercised a partial option of option year three for the period from December 3, 2022 through April 2, 2023, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$600,000.

35 (c) Modification No. 20 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option
36 year three and increase the not-to-exceed amount to \$1,740,000.

37 (d) Council approval is required by section 451(b) of the District of Columbia
38 Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1–
39 204.51(b)) since these modifications increase the value of the contract by more than \$1
40 million during a 12-month period.

41 (e) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
42 Without this approval, DigiDoc, Inc. cannot be paid for goods and services provided in
43 excess of \$1 million for the period from December 3, 2022 through December 2, 2023.

44 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
45 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
46 necessary that the Modification Nos. 19 and 20 to Human Care Agreement No.
47 CW77620 Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023 be adopted after
48 a single reading.

49 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
