A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 19 and 20 to Human Care Agreement No. CW77620 with DigiDoc, Inc. to provide nursing services to care for eligible students during transport to and from school and programs, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 19 and 20 to Human Care Agreement No. CW77620 with DigiDoc, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 19 and 20 to Human Care Agreement No. CW77620 with DigiDoc, Inc. to provide nursing services to care for eligible students during transport to and from school and programs and authorizes payment in the total

46 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
