A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 8, 9, and 10 to Contract No. CW87331 with CDE Systems to provide application development support for the District of Columbia Access System, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. CW87331 with CDE Systems Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 8, 9, and 10 to Contract No. CW87331 with CDE Systems to provide application development support for the District of Columbia Access System, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

(b) By Modification No. 8, dated November 28, 2022, the Office of Contracting and Procurement (OCP), on behalf of Department of Health Care Finance, partially exercised option year one of Contract No. CW87331 with CDE Systems for the period of December 10, 2022, through February 7, 2023, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$999,000.

35 (c) By Modification No. 9, dated February 8, 2023, OCP exercised a no-cost
36 extension of the partial exercise of option year one through March 9, 2023.

37 (d) Modification No. 10 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option
38 year one for the period of March 10, 2023 through December 9, 2023 in the not-to-
39 exceed amount of \$5,267,929.20, which will increase the total not-to-exceed amount for
40 option year one to \$6,266,929.20.

41 (e) Under section 451(b)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
42 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51(b)(1)),
43 Council approval is necessary since the modifications will increase the value of the
44 contract to more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

45 (f) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
46 Without this approval, CDE Systems cannot be paid for goods and services provided in
47 excess of \$1 million for the contract period beginning December 10, 2022 through
48 December 9, 2023.

49 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
50 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
51 necessary that the Modifications to Contract No. CW87331 with CDE Systems Approval
52 and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023 be adopted after a single reading.

53 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
