A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 2, 3, 4, and 5 to Contract No. CW92192 with Advanced Data Processing Inc. d/b/a ADPI to provide financial accountability services for the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. CW92192 with Advanced Data Processing, Inc. d/b/a ADPI Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council retroactively approves Modification Nos. 2, 3, and 4, and approves proposed Modification No. 5 to Contract No. CW92192 with Advanced Data Processing Inc. d/b/a ADPI to provide financial accountability services for the Fire and Emergency Medical

34 Services Department, and authorizes payment in the not-to-exceed amount of \$5,703,200  
35 for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

36           Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Chief Financial  
37 Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative  
38 Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code  
39 § 1-301.47a).

40           Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the  
41 event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain  
42 in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the  
43 District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,  
44 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
