A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. 1, 2, and 3 to Contract No. CW94739 with Ramsell Corporation to provide a secure, web-accessible platform that integrates core AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) pharmacy benefit managers, 340B inventory management, and insurance premium and co-pay management for both ADAP and the District-funded pre-exposure prophylaxis medication assistance programs, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. CW94739 with Ramsell Corporation Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to Section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modification Nos. 1, 2, and 3 to Contract No. CW94739 with Ramsell Corporation to provide a secure, web-accessible platform that integrates core ADAP pharmacy benefit managers, 340B inventory management, and insurance premium and co-pay management for both ADAP and the District-funded pre-exposure prophylaxis medication assistance programs, and authorizes payment in the not-to-exceed

36 amount of \$7,530,851.32 for the goods and services received and to be received under the
37 contract for the period from January 18, 2023 through January 17, 2024.

38 Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief
39 Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by Section 4a of the General
40 Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C.
41 Official Code § 1-301.47a).

42 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the
43 event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain
44 in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the
45 District of Columbia in Section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
46 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
