A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification No. 8 to Contract No. CW83888 with Accenture, LLP to provide contact tracing and other data management services to support critical operations to contain the spread of COVID-19 and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification No. 8 to Contract No. CW83888 with Accenture, LLP Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification No. 8 to Contract No. CW83888 with Accenture, LLP, to provide contact tracing and other data management services to support critical operations to contain the spread of COVID-19, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

(b) By Modification No. 8, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Health, exercised option year two of Contract No. CW83888 for \$15 million for the period May 20, 2022 through May 19, 2023.

36 (c) Council approval is necessary since this increased the value of the contract by  
37 more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

38 (d) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.  
39 Without this approval, Accenture, LLP cannot be paid for goods and services provided in  
40 excess of \$1 million for the period May 20, 2022 through May 19, 2023.

41 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the  
42 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it  
43 necessary that the Modification No. 8 to Contract No. CW83888 with Accenture, LLP  
44 Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023 be adopted after a single  
45 reading.
