33 To recognize and honor the Women’s National Democratic Club for working to educate, inform
34 and inspire the women and men of the District of Columbia and beyond to engage in political
35 action.

36 WHEREAS, the Women’s National Democratic Club celebrated their 100-year
37 anniversary in November 2022;

38 WHEREAS, the WNDC’s mission is to be a hub for civic engagement, learning and
39 political action in the heart of the nation’s capital;

40 WHEREAS, the WNDC has hosted many notable politicians, dignitaries, and other
41 speakers over the last century, most recently the newly elected Congress women of the 118th
42 Congress and the 3 women who served on the January 6 committee; and, on many occasions,
43 honored civic leaders-such as the Parkland Students, Dr. Dorothy Height and former Speaker of
44 the House, Nancy Pelosi;

45 WHEREAS, the WNDC Public Policy and Political Action committee advocates on both
46 national and international issues; and GOTV – Get Out the Vote - assist throughout the year
47 supporting candidates running for office through letter writing and informing voters;

48 WHEREAS, the WNDC’s Educational Foundation was established in 1991 to preserve
49 and educate the public on the history and accomplishments of women in the pursuit of social
50 justice in the nation and the District of Columbia; as well as to reach out to youth and the
51 community and preserve the Whittemore House in Dupont Circle;

52 Resolved, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, that this
53 resolution be cited as the “Women’s National Democratic Club Centennial Resolution of 2023”.

54 Sec.2. The Council of the District of Columbia honors the Women’s National Democratic
55 Club for its 100-year commitment to improving the lives of the citizens of the District of
56 Columbia.

57 Sec.3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the first date of publication in
58 the district of Columbia Register.
