- Hearing Record: The hearing record for all agencies under the Committee's jurisdiction will close at the close of business on April 14, 2023.

Witnesses testifying on their own behalf, and the second and any subsequent witnesses testifying on behalf of the same organization, will have three minutes for oral testimony. The Committee may reduce witnesses' time to accommodate additional witnesses but will inform those who have registered if it intends to do so.
