Councilmember Janeese Lewis George, Chair of the Committee on Facilities and Family Services will hold a public oversight hearing on the recently completed Office of the District of Columbia Auditor (ODCA) report entitled, "Multiple Failures Found in Roosevelt High School HVAC System," and the role of Consolidated Maintenance Contractors (CMCs) in school maintenance. The hearing will be held on **Thursday, May 25<sup>th</sup>**, **2023 at 12:00 p.m.** via zoom video conference.

ODCA engaged the independent firm, RSM US LLP, to review and report on the modernization of Roosevelt High School. This report was undertaken in compliance of D.C. Official Code § 38-2973.05 which requires the Office to prepare a report to "determine whether the District has met the process, quality, schedule and cost objectives of sampled projects, and provide a report to the Council and the public on the findings." The report describes DGS' efforts to maintain, repair, and determine likely causes for multiple failures in the heating ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) system at Roosevelt Senior High School. The team noted "a general theme of untimely action by both 3rd party vendors and DGS" with "several months/years [elapsing] between the identification of issues and the actions performed to assess to remediate those issues." This roundtable will examine the findings of the report, its recommendations for DGS, and DGS's response to the report. The roundtable will also discuss the role of Consolidated Maintenance Contractors (CMCs) in school maintenance.

Testimony is limited to 3 minutes for individuals and 5 minutes for one representative of a bone fide organization.
