23	Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve salary schedules for Career and
24	Excepted Service employees not covered by collective bargaining in the Fire and Emergency
25	Medical Services Department occupying the positions of Class 08 Battalion Chief, Class 08B
26	Battalion Chief Paramedic, Class 09 Deputy Chief, Class 09B Deputy Chief Paramedic, and
27	Class 10 Assistant Chief in order to provide parity with the salary schedules of union firefighters
28	and paramedics.
29	(b) The Mayor has transmitted to the Council proposed salary schedules for fiscal years
30	2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024 to implement pay parity for the positions referred to in subsection
31	(a) of this section.

32 (c) The Mayor has also proposed that the salary schedules for fiscal years 2021, 2022,
33 and 2023 apply retroactively.

34 (d) In order to implement these pay-parity provisions, the Department of Human
35 Resources and the Office of the Chief Financial Officer must carry out several lengthy
36 administrative and technological actions.

(e) It is important that these salary and pay adjustments be approved as soon as possible
so that the Department of Human Resources and the Office of the Chief Financial Officer can
promptly begin to carry out and complete these actions and uniformed members of the Fire and
Emergency Medical Services Department not covered by collective bargaining can benefit in a
timely manner from the additional income they will receive based on the updated salary
schedules.

43 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
44 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
45 Compensation System Changes for Non-Union, Uniformed Members of the Fire and Emergency
46 Medical Service Department Emergency Approval Resolution of 2023 be adopted on an
47 emergency basis.

48 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

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
