On Monday, May 15, 2023, Councilmember Kenyan R. McDuffie, Chairperson of the Committee on Business and Economic Development will hold a public roundtable to consider the following measures:

- Proposed Resolution 25-0178, the "D.C. Hebrew Language Charter School d/b/a/ Sela Public Charter School Revenue Bonds Project Approval Resolution of 2023"
- Proposed Resolution 25-0193, the "Washington International School Revenue Bonds Project Approval Resolution of 2023"

Proposed Resolution 25-0178 would authorize the issuance, sale, and delivery in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$15,000,000 of District of Columbia revenue bonds in one or more series and authorize the loan of the proceeds of the bonds to assist Sela in the financing, refinancing, or reimbursing of costs incurred by Sela for their project located at 6015-17 Chillum Place, NE, in Ward 4.

Proposed Resolution 25-0193 would authorize the issuance, sale, and delivery of tax-exempt revenue bonds, notes or other obligations in aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$62,000,000.00. These bonds will be used for the financing, refinancing, or reimbursing of costs incurred by the Washington International School for projects at their Tregaron campus located at 3100 Macomb St., NW, Washington, DC, 20018, in Ward 3.
