On Thursday, May 18, 2023, Councilmember Brooke Pinto, Chairwoman of the Committee on the Judiciary and Public Safety, will hold a roundtable on Proposed Resolution 25-139, the Homeland Security Commission Remaya Campbell Confirmation Resolution of 2023 and Proposed Resolution 25-140, the Homeland Security Commission Wendy Villatoro Confirmation Resolution of 2023. The roundtable will begin at 12:00 PM and be streamed live at dccouncil.gov and www.youtube.com/@cmbrookepinto.

PR25-139 would confirm Remaya Campbell as a member of the Homeland Security Commission. PR25-140 would re-confirm Wendy Villatoro as a member of the Homeland Security Commission.

Due to the imminent threat to the health, safety, and welfare of District residents posed by the spread of the coronavirus, the Council has adapted the methods by which committees may hold public hearings and roundtables to comply with social distancing, large public gatherings, and other public health and safety requirements. Therefore, this public roundtable will be held remotely through the Zoom teleconferencing platform.

The Committee invites the public to testify or to submit written testimony, which will be made a part of the official record. Anyone wishing to testify should contact Ms. Aukima Benjamin, Committee Manager to the Committee on the Judiciary and Public Safety, at least 24 hours prior to the start of the roundtable at (202) 724-8058 or via e-mail at judiciary@dccouncil.gov; witnesses will receive information on how to join the roundtable at that time. Witnesses who anticipate needing language interpretation, or requiring sign language interpretation, are requested to inform the Committee of the need as soon as possible but no later than five business days before the roundtable, which is May 11, 2023. We will make every effort to fulfill timely requests; however, requests received in less than five business days may not be fulfilled and alternatives may be offered.

If you are unable to testify at the public roundtable, written statements are encouraged and will be made a part of the official record; testimony may be submitted to judiciary@dccouncil.gov. The public may also leave voicemail testimony for the Committees by calling (202) 630-7585, which will be transcribed and made part of the official record. Members of the public leaving voicemail testimony should speak slowly and clearly, state their full name and the organization they represent, if any, and note the bill, hearing, or agency that they are submitting testimony on.

Members of the public are asked to not provide an e-mail, phone number, or other personal contact information in voicemail testimony.

The record will close at the end of the business day on June 1, 2023.
