A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modification Nos. M0015, and M0019 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 with Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative to provide community-based child welfare service delivery systems and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modification Nos. M0015, and M0019 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 with Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202(a) of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02(a)), the Council approves Modification Nos. M0015 and M0019 to Contract No. DCRL-2020-C-0105 with Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative to provide community-based child welfare service delivery systems, and authorizes payment in the

45 Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
46 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
