33	Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Contract No. NFPHC-
34	MS-22-C-00043 Modifications 10 & 11 ("Contract") between the Not-for-Profit Hospital
35	Corporation ("Hospital") and Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. for the provision
36	of nurse staffing services pertaining to the emergency department, intensive care unit, and

telemetry services, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be receivedunder this Contract.

39	(b) UMC determined that exercising Option Year 2 of the Contract was necessary
40	due to the ongoing need for nurses in the emergency department, ICU, and telemetry unit.
41	The Option Year 2 Modification #10 had a value of \$925,000.00 for the period of
42	December 10, 2022 through February 7, 2023, and was fully executed on December 13,
43	2022.
44	(c) Proposed Modification #11 for an additional \$2,500,000.00 and a period of
45	February 7, 2023 – December 9, 2023, is necessary to allow continued use of this
46	Contract. If approved, the combined value of Option Year 2 would be \$3,425,000.00 for
47	the period of December 10, 2022 – December 9, 2023, and would have an aggregate
48	value that exceeds \$1 million in a 12-month period; therefore, Council approval is
49	necessary.

(d) Without this approval, Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. cannot be
paid for these critical services to be provided in excess of \$999,999.99.

constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Contract No. NFPHC-MS22-C-00043 Modifications 10 & 11 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and
Maxim Healthcare Staffing Services, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization
Emergency Act of 2023, be adopted after a single reading.
