A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Human Care Agreement No. CW100362 with DC Doors, Inc., and Modification Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 thereto, to provide permanent supportive housing case management services, utility assistance, and financial assistance to highly vulnerable individuals and families experiencing homelessness, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the human care agreement and modifications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Human Care Agreement No. CW100362 with DC Doors, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2023”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to Section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Human Care Agreement No. CW100362 with DC Doors, Inc., and Modification Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 thereto, to provide permanent supportive housing case management services, utility assistance, and financial assistance to highly vulnerable individuals and families experiencing homelessness, and authorizes payment in the not-

43 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for  
44 no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of  
45 Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved  
46 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
