A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

---

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

---

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Human Care Agreement No. CW100362 with DC Doors, Inc., and Modification Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 thereto, to provide permanent supportive housing case management services, utility assistance, and financial assistance to highly vulnerable individuals and families experiencing homelessness, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the human care agreement and modifications.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Human Care Agreement No. CW100362 with DC Doors, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

Sec. 2.(a) There exists an immediate need to approve Human Care Agreement No. CW100362 with DC Doors, Inc., and Modification Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 thereto to provide permanent supportive housing case management services, utility assistance, and financial assistance to highly vulnerable individuals and families experiencing homelessness, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the human care agreement and modifications.

35 (b) On July 1, 2022, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the  
36 Department of Human Services, awarded Human Care Agreement No. CW100362 with  
37 DC Doors, Inc. for the period July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 in the not-to-exceed  
38 amount of \$950,000.

39 (c) Modification Nos. 1, 2, and 3 were administrative modifications.

40 (d) Modification No. 4 is now necessary to increase the not-to-exceed amount for  
41 the period July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 by \$1,606,925.19 to \$2,556,925.19.

42 (e) Council approval is required by section 451(b) of the District of Columbia  
43 Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-  
44 204.51(b)), since the contract value will be in excess of \$1 million during a 12-month  
45 period.

46 (f) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.  
47 Without this approval, DC Doors, Inc. cannot be paid for goods and services provided in  
48 excess of \$1 million for the contract period July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

49 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2  
50 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Human Care Agreement  
51 No. CW100362 with DC Doors, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency  
52 Act of 2023 be adopted after a single reading.

53 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
