

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve the proposed procurement regulations submitted by the District of Columbia Housing Authority.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “District of Columbia Housing Authority Procurement Regulations Approval Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023”.

Sec. 2. (a). Pursuant to section 20 of the District of Columbia Housing Authority Act of 1999, effective May 9, 2000 (D.C. Law 13-105; D.C. Official Code § 6-219), the District of Columbia Housing Authority (“DCHA”) has transmitted procurement regulations to the Council for a 45-day review period.

(b) These regulations will be deemed approved without Council action.

(c) Therefore, emergency legislation is necessary to ensure that the Council is able to approve the regulations in part before the end of the review period.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the District of Columbia Housing Authority Procurement Regulations Approval Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2023 be adopted after a single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
