WHEREAS, Judge Mary Rook In 1999, served as special education attorney in the civil division for the Public Defender Service, where she assisted the juvenile trial attorneys whose clients had outstanding special education needs;

WHEREAS, Judge Mary Rook served as Coordinator of the Juvenile Services Program for the Public Defender Service where she was responsible for training and supervising staff attorneys and law clerks that worked with Public Defender Service at the Oak Hill Youth Center and the Youth Services Center; and

WHEREAS, Judge Mary Rook was appointed by Chief Judge Rufus G. King, III and installed as Magistrate Judge on August 18, 2006.
